Transportation

Fullington Trailways, a bus company that travels from such places as Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and New York City to Penn State, will be providing those attendees who travel with them to the Regional Activity with the following incentives:

- 20% deducted from your total ticket price from any Fullington Trailways scheduled line run service.
- \$10 deducted from your total ticket price from any one-way Fullington Express bus. Purchase tickets online at "tickets.fullingtontours.com".
- \$20 deducted from your total ticket price from any round-trip Fullington Express bus. Purchase tickets online at "tickets.fullingtontours.com".

You will receive your refund through the mail after the conference. To do so, you will need to fill out the form found on the Regional Activity website and return it to one of the Regional Activity Coordinators during the conference. Forms will be available during the conference as well. **You must provide a copy of your ticket.**
